

VISAS

Before traveling to Spain, we recommend that you **contact the Spanish Embassy or Consulate** in your country to check whether you need a student visa.

Please note that requirements may vary depending on your nationality, so it's always best to confirm with the appropriate authorities to avoid any issues.

LEGAL ADVICE

The school does not process visas or offer legal advice.

However, we can recommend the independent law firm Olguín Abogados (<u>info@olguinabogados.com</u>). You can contact them directly for any questions about the visa process in Spain.

CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLING

- 1. **Full payment** of the course and any additional contracted services.
- 2. Indicate the **consulate** where your visa will be processed.
- 3. In case of visa refusal, we will refund the amount paid **minus a €400 administration fee** (other services will be assessed separately).
- 4. An **official copy of the visa resolution** (approved or denied) must be provided.

DURING YOUR STAY AT TARONJA

Breaks:

You may request breaks of up to **15% of the course duration (for courses under 20 weeks)** or **20% (for courses over 20 weeks)**. Breaks must be requested by **email** at least **1 week in advance**.

Mandatory attendance:

If unjustified absences exceed the allowed limit, the school is obligated to report it to the consulate.

ZIG-ZAG TIMETABLE

Shift 1: Monday, Wednesday and Friday (09:00–12:40) + Tuesday and Thursday (14:30–18:10) **Shift 2:** Monday, Wednesday and Friday (14:30–18:10) + Tuesday and Thursday (09:00–12:40)

The exact shift is confirmed weekly.

It is very important to keep this schedule in mind, as it changes every week. If you are considering working while in Valencia, please note that this depends on the specific conditions stated in your visa by the embassy. In any case, work is not considered a valid reason for missing classes.



ACCOMMODATION

Standard room (shared bathroom): €190/week **Superior room** (private bathroom): €250/week **Host family** with half board: €250/week

Accommodation is available for a maximum of 2 months, and by regulation, **registration** ("empadronamiento") is **not allowed.**

Please note that empadronamiento (registering at the local town hall) is a mandatory requirement for some types of visas or legal procedures in Spain, such as applying for a NIE (foreigner's identification number), residence card, or accessing certain public services.

VISA CANCELLATION

If your visa is rejected by the Spanish Embassy or Consulate, or you decide not to come for any reason, TARONJA will refund your money **except for 400€ for administration fees**.

In order to apply for a refund you must send us a copy of the refusal letter. Taronja has the obliggation to communicate to the Spanish authorities that your visa has been refused and that you can no longer travel to Spain.

ENROLLMENT

Please fill out the enrollment form and mention in the comments that you need **documentation for a visa.**

If you are a **complete beginner**, please check available starting dates beforehand.
